Dear Parent,

It has been said that an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure. We have a little situation at Landmark Christian School that I feel we need to work on before it becomes a problem. The issue is with having a parking lot that doubles as a playground. Any time you have moving vehicles mixed with children running and playing there is a potentially dangerous situation. We want to do all that we can to keep your children safe.

First I want to say thank you for the way that many of you have been so good about dropping off your students at the curb, and picking them up the same way. *Please do not pull into the parking lot even if the gate is not closed.* Any time that you come to the school whether it is to bring something to your students, or to pick them up, we are asking that you stop at the curb and not in the parking lot. *If there is not room to pull up to the curb on the same side of the street as the school, and you need to park across the street, please be sure to get out of your car and walk your students across the street.* Traffic on our street moves very fast, and with the bend in the road it is sometimes hard to see vehicles coming.

The second issue that could become a problem is that on rainy days parents want to drive right up to the school to drop off or pick up their students. All of us that drive understand that when it is raining we have less visibility than in clear weather. For the safety of our students we are asking that you pick up your students at the curb when it is raining. They may get a little wetter, but we would rather have them wet and safe than to deal with the other situation that could develop trying to keep them dry.

I do apologize for any inconvenience this may bring to you. However, I am sure that each of you would rather deal with this inconvenience than to deal with the inconvenience that could develop if we are not being careful.

Thank you for sharing this letter with anyone else that will be dropping off or picking up your students.
